

- **YoY FCF growth for tech companies is up 60%.** That level of financial strength is enabling bold moves in innovation and strategic acquisitions across the software landscape.
- **Private equity drives over 30% of global deal volume** – up 9% in the last 2 years, backed by \$2.5 trillion in dry powder. Software firms with scalable models and recurring revenue remain top targets as PE looks to deploy capital before year-end.
- **Global data center capacity is projected to nearly triple by 2030, with 70% of that demand driven by AI.** This massive infrastructure expansion, and the energy costs it entails, create a significant opportunity for software companies to develop solutions that optimize compute efficiency and reduce operational expenses.

## S&S M&A Weather Report

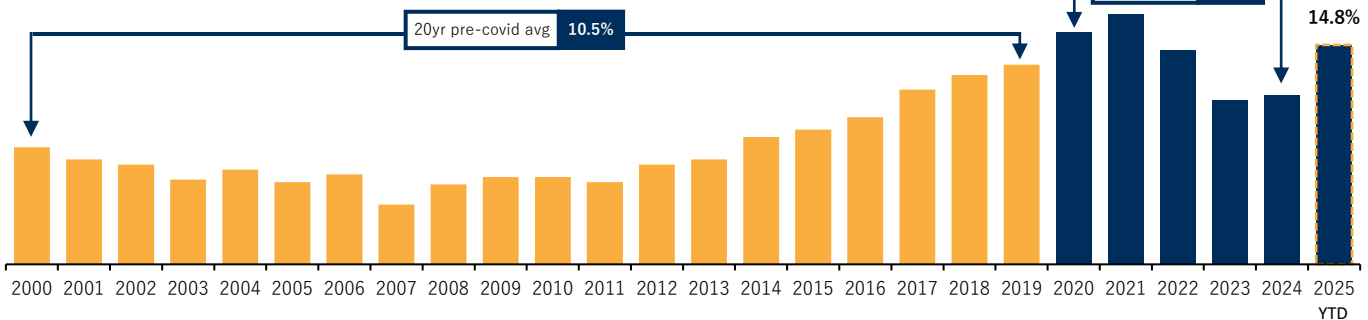

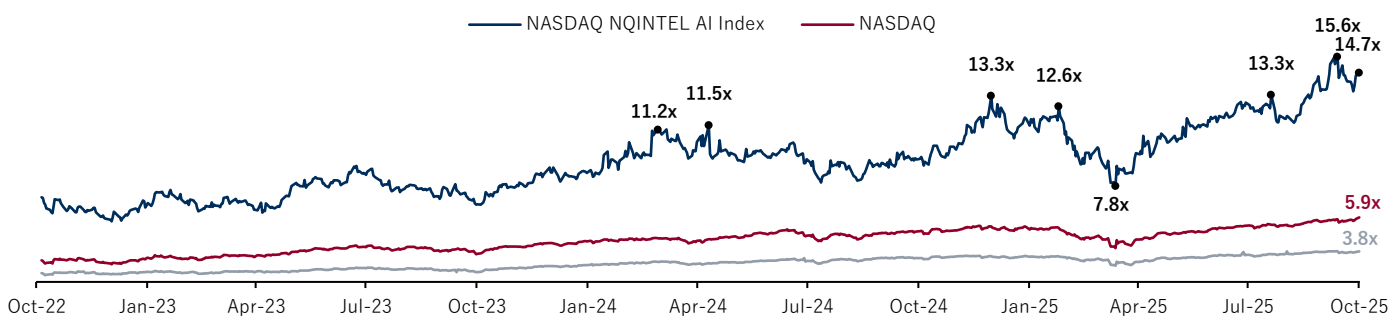

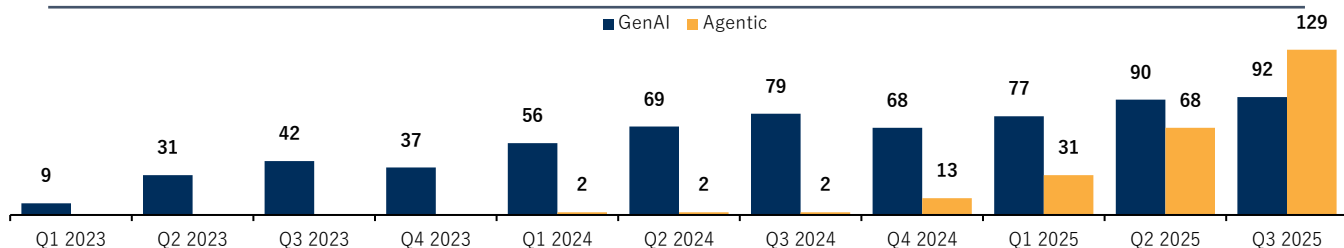

## From Generative Artificial Intelligence (GenAI) to Agentic







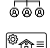





- ✓ **From Ideas to Execution:** Generative AI dominated early deal language post-ChatGPT, appearing in nearly 400 transactions between 2023 and 2024. Initially, acquirers used GenAI as a buzzword rather than a core capability, signaling intent more than execution.
- ✓ **Why Agentic is Favored Now:** Agentic AI systems use iterative reasoning frameworks to break down complex objectives into executable subtasks, self-correcting and maintaining context as they work - eliminating the need to manually prompt each step. This architectural evolution transforms AI from a question-answering tool into an autonomous workflow executor that can handle multi-stage business processes from initiation to completion.
- ✓ **Deal Volume Acceleration:** Mentions of "agentic AI" in tech M&A records are projected to surge 20x in 2025, overtaking generative AI references for the first time. This reflects a strategic pivot toward automation and scalability.
- ✓ **Strategic Use Cases:** Agentic AI is being deployed for continuous pipeline monitoring, automated diligence checks, and post-merger integration workflows - areas where GenAI struggled due to its prompt-dependent nature.
- ✓ **Financial Signal:** Workday's \$2B+ acquisition strategy targeting agentic AI platforms, including FlowiseAI, demonstrates the substantial value enterprise buyers assign to agent orchestration capabilities.
